Narrator 1	Last week in R.E. we were reading about Jesus' disciple Peter
Narrator 2	Peter had been one of the first people Jesus called to follow him
Narrator 1	Peter went everywhere with Jesus, watching him heal people, listening to him preach.
Narrator 2	But one Thursday night Peter saw Jesus get arrested
Narrator 1	He was terrified too. He might have thought he was in danger himself.
Narrator 2	Watch what happened. Jesus had been arrested and was taken to the High Priest's House. Peter waited outside in the courtyard.
Servant girl	You were with Jesus of Galilee
Peter	I don't know what you are talking about
Narrator 1	Peter went out to the entrance of the courtyard
Servant girl 2 to a group of men	He was with Jesus of Nazareth
Peter	I swear that I don't know that man
Man 1 to Peter	You are definitely one of them
Man 2	Your accent tells me
Peter	I swear I am telling the truth.
Narrator 2	Then Peter realised what he had done and felt very sad.
Narrator 1	Jesus forgave Peter.
Narrator 2	When Jesus died and rose again he appeared to his disciples.
Narrator 1	He had a special message for Peter. He asked him if he loved him. Peter replied that he did. Jesus asked him three times
Narrator 2	That matched the 3 times Peter had said he didn't know Jesus

Narrator 1	Jesus told him to take care of his people from that day forward
Narrator 2	And that's what Peter did. He told everyone the good news of Jesus and even went to jail himself for being a follower of Jesus.
Narrator 1	Lots of churches and schools are called St Peter in his honour.
Narrator 2	Peter's story reminds us to be loyal and brave.
